Staff & Volunteer Screening Policy

The Etobicoke Youth Soccer Club supports and complies with the Volunteer Screening Guidelines and Requirements of The Ontario Soccer Association.

All COMPETITIVE and RECREATIONAL TEAM coaches and registered Team Staff shall comply with the policy and procedures set out below:

HIGH RISK POSITIONS

Team Officials (coaches, assistant coaches, managers) of Competitive teams who play in District, Regional and Provincial Leagues are deemed High Risk Positions and must comply with the following screening measures:

- Complete and submit an EYSC Application form for each season (indoor and outdoor) and for each team that they are listed as a team official
- Police Record Check (which must include a Vulnerable Sector check) are good for one year and must be dated no earlier than September 30 of the previous year. Returning coaches, or any competitive team staff member with EYSC, must submit an up to date PRC including Vulnerable Sector Check annually
- New Team Officials, must also arrange a screening interview with the Club Head Referee.
- New Coaches and Assistant Coaches must provide the club with copies of current OSA coaching certificate, Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders certificate, Making Ethical Decisions Certificate and Making Headway - Concussion Module. Managers must also provide their Respect in Sport for Activity Leaders certification.

All RECREATIONAL TEAM coaches and registered Team Staff shall comply with the policy and procedures set out below:

MEDIUM RISK POSITIONS

All Youth Recreational Team Officials (for ages 13 to 18 inclusive) are deemed Medium Risk and must comply with the following screening measures:

- EYSC Application Form
- Police Record Check (which must include a Vulnerable Sector check) are good for 3 years and must be dated no earlier than September 30 of the previous year.
- Respect in Sports for Activity Leaders certification

LOW RISK POSITIONS

Youth Recreational Team Officials and Mini Soccer Team Officials are deemed Low Risk and must comply with the following screening measures:

- EYSC Application form
- Police Record Check (which must include a Vulnerable Sector check) are good for 3 years and must be dated no earlier than September 30 of the previous year.
